1st Q All Head Start classrooms in Clay, Dickinson, O'Brien and Osceola received dental screenings. Helping families' access dental care has become increasingly difficult. Fewer dentist are willing to participate with the Dental Wellness for Kids program (replaced children's Medicaid Dental). As fewer children are able to access preventive dental care, the services provided through the I-Smile™ program are more important than ever.
